Dear Senator Borah

It appears they have dismantled the state of the art alarm system that was to be sounded if there was an accident. I saw Mr. Knight on TV 6 out of Tulsa, and his arrogance was appalling. Not to mention his stupidity that he did not know he was to call the NRC and he waited 24 hours before he did so. If this is the kind of pointed headed jerk running such a dangerous plant as this, you need to investigate it from top to bottom, as I have wrote you before to many people have, and are dying from cancer in this County. We need a cancer survey done. To many people have cancer & the sloppy way this plant is run and has been run since day one, can only contribute to this cancer, we know of over 250 people who have died of cancer.
