CONFERENCE SUMMARY

NRC Enforcement Conference Report No. 03013255/2006002

On August 9, 2006, NRC held a Predecisional Enforcement Conference with representatives of Triad Engineering, Inc. The conference was held in the Region I office located in King of Prussia, Pennsylvania, to discuss the apparent violations described in NRC Inspection Report No. 03013255/2006001. The conference was open to the public, but no members of the public were in attendance.

Mr. Frank Costello, Director, Division of Resource Management, made the opening remarks and briefly described the purpose of the conference. Mr. John Wray, Region I Enforcement Specialist, described the enforcement process and the NRC Enforcement Policy. Mr. John D. Kinneman briefly described the nature of violations, and requested the licensee to respond to each of the violations and provide reasons for any disputed violation(s), and to point out any factual error(s) in the inspection report. He also requested the licensee to provide details of the corrective actions that they have instituted and plan to institute to prevent recurrence of the violations.

Mr. Randy Moulton, President of Triad Engineering, Inc., responded by first expressing the licensee's concern for the violations and its commitment to conduct licensed activities in full compliance with regulatory requirements. He acknowledged the violations and stated that the NRC report accurately described the facts. He described the immediate corrective actions which included the termination of the authorized user and the retraining of all authorized users at their Purcellville, Virginia, field office and the scheduled retraining of all authorized users at all Branch Offices.

Mr. Lloyd Winters, Radiation Safety Officer of the Winchester Branch stated that an increase in the frequency of unannounced audits of authorized users will be implemented to ensure that all authorized users meet the regulatory requirements. Specifically, he outlined a plan to conduct random weekly audits of authorized users at temporary job sites for a period of approximately one year.

Mr. John Wray provided closing comments on the enforcement policy and enforcement options available to the NRC.

Mr. Costello thanked the licensee's representatives for their attendance, patience, and presentations, and adjourned the meeting.
