The purpose of this modification is to provide incremental funding in the amount of \$18,500 thereby increasing the obligated amount of the task order from \$30,000 to \$48,500. The total amount of the task order, \$53,632 remains unchanged.

Accordingly, the following changes are made:

"Task Order No. 16 shall be effective from March 6, 2006 through December 31, 2006 with a total cost ceiling of \$53,632.00 of which \$52,324.00 represents the reimbursable costs and \$1,308 represents the fixed fee.

Incremental funds in the amount of \$18,500 are being obligated under this modification, thereby increasing the total obligated amount of this Task Order from \$30,000 to \$48,500. The obligated amount shall, at no time, exceed the task order ceiling. When and if the amount(s) paid and payable to the Contractor hereunder shall equal the obligated amount, the Contractor shall not be obligated to continue performance of the work unless and until the Contracting Officer increases the amount obligated with respect to this Task Order. Any work undertaken by the Contractor in excess of the obligated amount specified above is done so at the Contractor's sole risk."
