Dear Mr. Fliegel and Surovchak:

As we discussed in our meetings earlier this year, we are nearing the final phase of reclamation at our Highland Uranium Project in Wyoming. One of the remaining tasks is to finalize the long-term care boundary that will define the property that will be transferred to the Department of Energy at license termination. We would like to propose a meeting with both the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and Department of Energy (DOE) at the site to introduce you to the site and to further discussions about the extent of the long-term care boundary.

We have had initial discussions with the NRC, DOE and the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality (WDEQ) regarding the boundary in general and the inclusion of the mine pit specifically into the boundary. We would like to set a time to have you and other appropriate people from your agency to come to the site so we can continue the process.

We would propose a site meeting in mid to mid September, perhaps during the week of September 11-15 or at a time convenient to each of you.
