2) Physical Description

This shipment will consist of (5) Cylinders of Uranium Hexafluoride (UF6) in sealed Overpacks. The cylinders are 30-B Cylinders containing 7,700 kgs Uranium enriched to approximately 5% weight of U-235.

3) Transportation and Route Schedule

The ocean transportation from Antwerp, Belgium to Baltimore, MD will be the responsibility of Atlantic Container Line. The inland transportation from Baltimore, MD to Westinghouse/Columbia, SC will be the responsibility of RSB LOGISTIC SERVICES INC. Entry into the United States will occur at Baltimore, MD on or about 27 April, 2000.

Shipment Routing

Sails Antwerp, Belgium via "Atlantic Conveyor" V. 0242 on 12 April 2000, arrives Baltimore, MD on 27 April, 2000.
