DESCRIPTION OF MATERIALS OR FACILITIES

The licensee is authorized to export a total of 60 curies of Cobalt-60 (Co-60) contained in sealed sources. The Co-60 sealed sources are located in Ohmart SHF-4 gauges in SAIC VACIS units. Each VACIS unit contains a maximum of two sealed sources. Each Co-60 sealed source is less than or equal to one curie (nominal activity). Each SAIC VACIS unit is a separate shipment.

Conditions 1, 2, and 3 of this license apply to this export.

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Neither this license or any right under this license shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the provisions of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974.

This license is subject to the right of recapture or control by Section 108 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and to all of the other provisions of said Acts, now or hereafter in effect and to all valid rules and regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

LICENSE CONDITIONS:

- 1) The exporter, SAIC, must inform the ultimate consignee, the Iraqi Government, in writing of all license conditions.
- 2) SAIC's Supply Agreement with the Iraqi Government shall contain the following terms and conditions:
 - a. No resale, transfer, or re-export of the items listed on this license is authorized without prior written authorization of the U.S. Government.
 - b. The Co-60 sources and the Mobile VACIS host vehicles will be subject to all the provisions contained in the Security Plan for VACIS, which is attached to the June 27, 2006, letter from Richard J. K. Stratford, DOS to Janice Dunn Lee, NRC and is included on Pages 3 through 7 of this license.
- 3) SAIC shall confirm each delivery of the exported Co-60 sealed sources and the corresponding Mobile VACIS host vehicles to the ultimate consignee, the Iraqi Government, referencing the NRC license number to the NRC.
