in Commercial Contract for Uranium Water Treatment Operations**

Dear Mike:

In response to your inquiry of August 28, 2006, regarding R.M.D. Operations, LLC's (RMD's) August 14, 2006 submission of its financial assurance package for its proposed multi-site, service provider license, RMD hereby proposes that the following language be added to its commercial contract, so that NRC would be considered an intended third-party beneficiary in RMD's commercial uranium water treatment contract:


Insert the following language in Section 4.7 of the August 14, 2006 commercial contract submission:

"For purposes of this Agreement, if applicable, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission shall be considered an intended third-party beneficiary of any financial assurance mechanism required for activities under this Agreement and shall be granted rights to enforce the provisions of such financial assurance mechanism for decommissioning or other related activities."

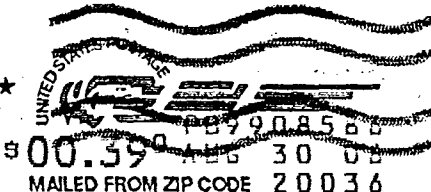
