INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

ACCEPTANCE: This is to advise you that those individuals in Enclosure 1 have been accepted for participation in the training course (H-308), "Transportation of Radioactive Materials." This course is scheduled to be presented October 16-20, 2006, at the NRC Technical Training Center (TTC), 5746 Marlin Road, Suite 200, Osborne Office Center, Near Eastgate Shopping Center, Chattanooga, Tennessee 37411-5677, Telephone (423) 855-6500, Fax (423) 855-6543.

COURSE: This course will be conducted beginning at 8:00 a.m. and ending at 5:00 p.m., each day except for Friday, October 20, 2006, when the class is scheduled to end at 3:00 p.m. Please see course outline below. Students should bring an engineering or scientific calculator with them. Cellular phones and similar devices with audible capability should be disabled while classes are in session. Normal office/business attire is appropriate for students attending TTC courses.

LODGING & TRAVEL: You should plan to arrive on Sunday, October 15, 2006, and depart on Friday, October 20, 2006. Participants must make their own lodging and travel arrangements.
