In a telephone conversation of August 16, 2006, you requested the following information pertaining to our June 19, 2006 Amendment Request to change the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) from Leonard J. Duquette to Michael J. Pretti:

1. We request the License Items 8.A. and 8.B be amended to the following possession limits:
 - a. 150 millicuries for Cs-137 and 750 millicuries for Am-241.
2. Mr. Pretti has approximately 21 years of experience (1985 to present) using a portable nuclear density gauge.
3. Attached to this correspondence is a document signed by Mr. Gerald Sevick, Chief Operating Officer of Foth & Van Dyke, confirming Mr. Pretti's appointment as RSO.
