The following are my observations/questions on the [REDACTED] interview (10/23/03)

ASSESSMENT QUESTION	YES/NO	AMPLIFICATION (WHY, WHY NOT, ETC.)
Will raise concerns and has done so before?	YES	Told management he thought they took too long to shutdown in response to a stuck BF-19 main feed reg valve (6)
Raises concerns for others?	NO	N/A
Believes others raise concerns without hesitation?	YES	He thinks timid people may be afraid to raise concerns (3) No specific examples (3a)
Knows of someone who has experienced retaliation for raising concerns?	YES	Shop steward fired, possibly at instigation of ops manager - sued, won reinstatement. No specific issue stated prompting this action (4) He thinks personnel assigned less pleasant tasks for raising issues - gives an example of an individual considered to be a "roadblock" due to refusing to take procedural shortcuts (5)
Technical Issues identified	YES	Circumstances of BF-19 issue as above (6)
Production over Safety?	YES	In questionable situations - took too long to determine TS3.0.3 shutdown was required due to a stuck main feed reg valve BF19 because it was obviously a mechanical, not a control problem (1) Not when a clear-cut situation exists (2)
