- (e)(1) If any part of any fee imposed under this chapter is not paid within fifteen (15) days of the due date, a penalty of five percent (5%) of the amount due shall at once accrue and be added thereto. Thereafter, on the first day of each month during which any part of any fee or any prior accrued penalty remain unpaid, an additional penalty of five percent (5%) of the then unpaid balance shall accrue and be added thereto.
