Dear Marleen,

This is to confirm your appointment as Radiation Safety Officer for Gifford Medical Center's medical use license. You are responsible for ensuring the safe use of radiation. You are responsible for managing the radiation protection program; identifying radiation protection problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; stopping unsafe activities; and ensuring compliance with regulations. You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of byproduct material by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations where justified by radiation safety. You are required to notify management of situations where staff are not cooperating and not addressing radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise issues with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission at anytime. It is estimated that you will spend time as needed conducting radiation protection activities, to include quarterly reviews of all activities utilizing radioactive materials.
