Dear Sir or Madame:

I am writing to make a request under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, and its related statutes and regulations, as detailed below:

- Any and all records of communication (including but not limited to letters, written requests, reports, telephone records, electronic communication) between your agency and Fred D. Thompson or his offices/staff, from 1994-2002, during which period he was a United States Senator.
- Any and all FOIA requests filed with your agency since January 1, 2001 dealing with Fred Thompson.

Index: If this request would generate a substantial number of documents, we would prefer to have an index of the documents, a database printout of correspondence or the like, and reduce time and processing costs by selecting specific documents from such an index to receive in their entirety.

Redactions: I am requesting to receive as much information as possible, including documents and pages that can be partially provided with redactions, as provided under the relevant statutes and regulations.

Format: I would prefer if possible to receive as much of this information as possible in an electronic form, be it on diskette, CD, via e-mail or Internet download (FTP) or other format. This is particularly the case if it reduces the time or cost involved in processing requests.

Flexibility In Request: Please feel free to contact me to discuss ways to change the scope or amend this request in order to speed its processing. I am certainly willing to make modifications to better suit the format and availability of information you maintain, or to utilize a search done for a similar FOIA request.


Documents At Other Agencies: Please inform me of any other relevant agencies or offices, be they federal, state or local, which may maintain any relevant records relating to this request.
