Dear Mr. Joyce:

By letter dated May 18, 2007<sup>1</sup>, you submitted an affidavit executed by Barbara A. Agans on behalf of Continuum Dynamics, Inc. (C.D.I.), dated May 10, 2007, requesting that the information contained in the following document be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 2, Section 2.390:

"Limit Curve Analysis for Dryer Stress Prediction During Power Ascension," C.D.I. letter No. 07086

A nonproprietary copy of this document<sup>2</sup> has been placed in the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Public Document Room and added to the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Public Electronic Reading Room. The affidavit stated that the submitted information should be considered exempt from mandatory public disclosure for the following reasons:

- 3(a) a process or method, including supporting data and analysis, where prevention of its use by C.D.I.'s competitors without license from C.D.I. constitutes a competitive advantage over other companies;
- 3(b) Information which, if used by a competitor, would reduce his expenditure of resources or improve his competitive position in the design, manufacture, shipment, installation, assurance of quality, or licensing of a similar product;
- 3(c) Information which discloses patentable subject matter for which it may be desirable to obtain patent protection.
