This is in reference to your letter dated June 8, 2007 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 45-25631-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Your amendment request to change the radiation safety officer should have been signed by a management representative rather than the proposed radiation safety officer. Please submit a letter signed by a management representative indicating that management has reviewed the amendment request and concurs in the statements and representations contained therein. Note also that a management representative should sign all future correspondence that requests a change in your license.
