Thanks, Larry, for the quick update.

A few clarifications:

1. Does the percent complete indicate that the total actions are completed, or that billing/payment is completed? Do you expect additional bills for waste characterization, or packaging/transport to Barnwell?
2. Because you left the 'percent complete' blank for envirocare wastes, I assume that no actions and/or no billing was incurred so far for these activities.
3. Solutient referenced several sections of the Settlement Agreement in their proposal, all of which referred to the pre-2000 tritium waste. Will any of the wastes currently being generated be included in shipments to Envirocare, or will you have to obtain another contract and estimate for that?

Larry,

I just received your 7/17/07 request for additional funds from the trust account. I am attaching a table, based on the Solutient January 2006 proposal, of the estimated costs and actual costs, as we understand them. Before we release additional funds, I need you to review this table and let me know of any changes/corrections/etc. In the bill submitted with the June 27, 2007, letter, Solutient indicated that waste packaging was "23%" completed. Does this 23% refer to Barnwell waste, or all tritium wastes? We would like an estimate of the percent completion for the different tasks listed in Solutient's proposal.

I used Wordperfect to develop the table, then converted it to Word, so you may have trouble manipulating it. If you do, just print out a copy and fax me a marked up/corrected copy.

Also, the letter approving the 6/27/07 request for funds was signed July 13 and mailed out yesterday. I am attaching a pdf copy of that letter.
