<p>Summary: In the letter dated June 21, 2007, the licensee requested that I-131 use be added back to their license. I-131 use was removed when the only AU left the institution. Nripendra Devanath, M.D. is an AU listed on the license who is also listed on License No. 13-00951-03 for the use of I-131 &lt; 33 millicuries. I spoke to Ms. Neuman to discuss the possession limit of 30 millicuries that she requested in the letter. We discussed that the limit would include waste as well as doses. After additional consideration she stated that she would like the possession limit to be 100 millicuries.</p>
