

# Design Centered Working Group Presentation Combined License/Design Certification Acceptance Review

July 24, 2007

- Goals of Acceptance Review
  - Determine if applicant has provided information required by regulations
  - Assess the quality of the application
  - Develop an application-specific review plan and schedule
- Scope of Acceptance Review
  - Completeness: Has the applicant provided the information in their application required by the regulations? (Reference: RG 1.206, Section C.IV.1)
  - Technical sufficiency: Is the information provided by the applicant of sufficient depth such that the staff can perform the review?
    - Sufficient scope to cover each SRP review area
    - Review areas where the NRC has previously asked RAIs (not for areas that have already been certified where there is no deviation from design)
    - New approaches/systems not previously reviewed by the NRC
    - Unique deviations from the certified design
    - Address COL Action information items from previously certified designs
  - Schedule: Are the planning assumptions consistent with the application?
- Duration
  - **Generally** plan to conduct the review in 60 calendar days from receipt of application
- NRC/Applicant Interactions
  - Anticipate frequent telecons with NRC project managers on status
  - Technical issues with application will be raised with applicant in telecons
  - May issue draft RAIs via E-mail to facilitate telecons
  - May identify information needed to supplement application
  - NRC may request a public meeting with the applicant during the acceptance review if necessary
- Status
  - NRC staff developing office instruction that will be publically available
