Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Source Material License No. SMB-920, as renewed.

This license authorizes the processing of tin slags up to the magnetic separation process. Attachment #2 of your application indicates the source material content of the magnetic fraction from the magnetic separation process is less than 0.05% by weight. However, we note in Table 5, attachment #3, of your application that the magnetic fraction may contain greater than 0.05% by weight thorium, in which case licensing for the chemical recovery of tantalum and columbium would be required.

Please note Item 9 of this license includes the B-11 Yard, Canton Railroad Pier, Baltimore, Maryland, as an authorized place of storage for source material. Accordingly, Source Material License No. STB-849 which also authorizes storage at the above location is hereby terminated. Also note, that since your application did not describe the activities to be conducted at your Boyertown, Pennsylvania facility, we have not included the Boyertown facility as an authorized place of use under this license.

Your request for an exemption to Section 20.301 to permit disposal of the tin slag residues in a manner not otherwise authorized by 10 CFR 20 is under review. We will contact you at a latter date in regard to this matter.
