ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS TO MEET IN ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND, SEPTEMBER 6-8

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) will hold a public meeting Sept. 6-8, in Rockville, Md., to discuss, among other items, a final review of the license renewal application for the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station. In addition, the committee will discuss the draft ACRS report on the NRC safety research program and review a draft report on the quality of selected NRC research projects.

The ACRS advises the Commission on licensing and operation of nuclear power plants and related safety issues.

The meeting will be held in Room T-2B3 of the agency's Two White Flint North building, at 11545 Rockville Pike.
