Dear Ms. Duft:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff has received your letter dated August 7, 2007, regarding the Delineation Agreement between Mallinckrodt, Inc. (Mallinckrodt) and the US Army Corps of Engineers (Government) for Responsibilities at Plant 6 West. We request that you clarify whether Mallinckrodt intended to request that NRC not disclose the information contained in the agreement from the public, but neglected to file the necessary petition to request withholding of the information. If that is the case, we request that you file a petition pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390 by no later than September 1, 2007. In addition, your letter indicates that Mallinckrodt plans to begin the removal of the Colombian-Niobium residuals in the trenches by October 2007. Please note that, until Mallinckrodt's August 13, 2007 license amendment application has been approved by the staff, and incorporated as a condition into your NRC license, Mallinckrodt would not be authorized to conduct decommissioning activities in the trenches.
