Attached for your comments and concurrence, as agreed at the November 12 meeting at State Department, is a redraft of the USSR nuclear safety cooperation proposal and a draft cable forwarding it to the U.S. Embassy in Moscow for delivery to the Soviets.

As agreed, we have shortened the proposed agreement so it focuses on the overall framework for safety cooperation and leaves details of implementation to later arrangements to be developed by the Coordinating Committee which is established by the agreement. We have also tried to tighten up the draft to avoid duplication and to make the scope more specific, i.e. commercial nuclear reactor safety. We have also sought to take into account comments provided by DOE and DOD staff on the Soviet draft proposal.

I would appreciate comments/concurrence being provided to Howard Faulkner, GPA/IP (492-4323) by December 4.
