The overall enrollment could be increased by approximately 700-800 students to a system wide enrollment of approximate of 5500. Therefore the system could handle a possible 17% increase without having to make adjustments to facilities and programs.

Dear Mr. Roberts,

Thank you very much for agreeing to meet with me and my colleagues on Wednesday October 18th at 1PM, in your office located in Waynesboro.

As you know, the Southern Nuclear Operating Company has applied to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to expand its operating license for the Vogtle Nuclear Plant. In order to meet the requirements for reviewing a nuclear plant's operating license, NRC must submit an analysis of the environmental and economic impacts associated with this new license. The impact statement must also include an assessment any impacts on low income or minority populations in an effort to ensure that these populations are not disproportionately impacted in an adverse manner by the possible expansion construction and expanded operation of the plant.

The purpose of this meeting will be to collect regional information to help us evaluate the economic impacts of the Vogtle Nuclear power plant on surrounding counties. In Burke County, one of the major impacts the plant has is related to county tax revenues and school funding. Because of this, we would like to capture more information on the Burke County School district, how it operates, and how it is impacted by the existence and operation of the Vogtle Nuclear plant. If possible, we would like to collect additional information on some of the issues related to low-income and/or minority populations in Burke County, from your perspective, and how the possible expansion of the Vogtle plant may impact these populations. I did not specifically mention this topic in my phone conversation with you last week, so if there is another person from your district office that you feel would be more appropriate to address these latter topics, please let me know (or feel free to invite them to our meeting).

Below, please find a tentative list of the topics I would like to discuss during the meeting:

Overall picture of the School District's finances and what some

of the major sources of revenue are for the district.

Capacity rates at schools and how an influx of several thousand construction workers might impact this capacity and student-teacher ratios.

Effects of major employers, developments, economic trends in the area on schools and poor populations.

Discussion of the possible construction and operation of an expanded Vogtle plant might have on low income and minority populations in Burke County.

Locations of any concentrations of poor and minority populations in the Burke County.
