Dear Mr. Lynch:

This refers to the letter dated July 17, 2007, requesting written consent to withdraw \$29,130.02 from the NRC-controlled decommissioning trust fund. We understand that these funds are needed to complete payment for the packaging and transportation for disposal at the Barnwell facility of the high-activity tritium wastes from pre-2000 licensed activities. Because the characterization and disposal of tritium wastes from pre-2000 licensed activities is essential to the successful closure of activities at the site by December 31, 2007, this expenditure falls within the provisions of Condition 19.A. of your license. Accordingly, you are authorized to use an additional \$29,130.02 of the decommissioning trust fund to pay for work done to package and transport for disposal the high-activity tritium wastes from pre-2000 licensed activities.

Based on the January 26, 2006, proposal from your contractor, we understand that you still have to package, transport and dispose of lower activity tritium wastes from pre-2000 licensed activities at the Envirocare facility. In your next correspondence, please provide us with your estimated date of when these activities will be completed.
