Dear Dr. Qazi

In order to continue my review of your license application, I need the following information:

1. Please confirm that your proposed location of use is not a location of use for any other active NRC license.
2. Your application appears to indicate that your location of use may be controlled by an entity other than yourself. If so, please provide documentation of a lease or a clear contractual agreement concerning access to your location of use for the purpose of decontamination or removal of licensed material from the location of use in the event of disharmony between you and the owner entity. This documentation should consist of signed certification from both parties.
3. Concerning the base location in Herndon, VA, is Precision Nuclear subleasing the entire area depicted in the provided floor plan or certain rooms? If Precision Nuclear is subleasing a portion of the facility, indicate on the diagram the specific rooms and the purpose for which each room is used (i.e. receipt/storage of licensed material, injection of licensed material, imaging, waste storage). In addition, describe how Precision Nuclear will (1) assure that only their trained staff will have access to the licensed material and (2) secure the licensed material from unauthorized removal.
4. Please confirm that the transportation of licensed materials will be in accordance with 10 CFR Part 71 (enclosed) and Department of Transportation regulations.
5. Please note that you are not required to provide a list of temporary job-sites to the NRC as part of your license application. 10 CFR 35.80(a)(1) requires that, the licensee obtain a letter signed by the management of each client for which services are rendered that permits the use of byproduct material at the client's address. This letter must clearly delineate the authority and responsibility of the licensee and the client. 10 CFR 35.80(c) requires the licensee to maintain a copy of the letter between the licensee and the client and the record of each survey performed at the client's site. This information may be reviewed during NRC inspections.
