Dear Mr. Director:

We concerned citizens living less than 3 miles from Nuclear Fuel Services plant in Emery, Tenn. We are requesting an extension of time for a hearing on the above matter due to the fact we were given very little information by the public documentarian. We were under the impression we had 30 business days to request a hearing and only found out this weekend per second opinion that the deadline for request was today, Aug. 20, 2007.

Due to this error we are requesting a 30 day extension for a hearing due to the amount of correspondence and paperwork to be sent to the N.R.C. concerning this matter which denied the citizens of Emery and Union Co. and all surrounding counties our due process rights as mandated by Section 189 of the Atomic Energy Act when it withheld public notice of N.R.C.'s Feb. 21, 2007 Confirmatory Order that Modified N.T.S. Special Nuclear Material License and the spill of highly enriched Uranium in March 2006 at the N.T.S. plant that was kept secret from the public.

We respectfully urge the N.R.C. Commission to assist to the "community's right to know" about the health and safety aspects of this nuclear facility.
