This matter is before the court on Intervenor Hydro Resources, Inc.'s Motion for Clarification and Extension of Time (the "Motion"). The part of the Motion requesting an extension of time to file Intervenor's brief is unopposed. The Motion is granted, as provided below.

An intervenor normally must file a joint brief with the parties on the "side" with which intervention was granted. 10th Cir. R. 31.3(A). Intervenor and Respondents need not comply with this rule in this appeal, however, because governmental entities are

exempt from the joint briefing requirement. *Id.* 31.1(D). Nevertheless, this rule establishes that the Intervenor's brief in this appeal would be due at the same time as Respondents' brief.

Inteviewer shall have 30 days from the date of this order within which to file its brief. No further extensions may be granted on the clerk's authority.
