MEMORANDUM

(Issuance of Draft Environmental Impact Statement)

On August 30, 2007, the NRC staff issued a publicly available letter (ML072400469), in which it (1) noted the “issuance” of its safety evaluation report (SER) for this proceeding, albeit with open items; and (2) stated that the SER was being withheld from public disclosure for fourteen days to permit applicant Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC) to review the document for confidential information in accordance with 10 C.F.R. § 2.390. While indicating that “[i]ssuance of this SER is an important milestone in the staff’s rigorous review to determine whether SNC’s application meets the Commission’s regulations,” as far as we can determine that letter was not served on or otherwise provided to the Licensing Board (or the Joint Intervenors<sup>1</sup>), notwithstanding the fact that the Board will be conducting the mandatory hearing for this application that will include a review of the SER. See CLI-07-24, 66 NRC \_\_ (Aug. 30, 2007).

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<sup>1</sup> The Joint Intervenors include the Center for a Sustainable Coast, Savannah Riverkeeper, Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, Atlanta Women’s Action for New Directions, and Blue Ridge Environmental Defense League.

The staff currently is scheduled to issue the draft environmental impact statement (DEIS) for this proceeding on September 14, 2007. As the general schedule for this proceeding indicates, a number of filing deadlines are triggered by the issuance and availability of the DEIS. See Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Prehearing Conference and Initial Scheduling Order) (May 7, 2007) at app. A (unpublished). As a consequence, it is the Board's hope that the staff will make both the Joint Intervenors and the Board aware of this environmental document's issuance and availability on a timely basis.
