Gentlemen:

In accordance with 10 CFR 30 we hereby submit our application for renewal of Byproduct Material License No. 4-698-1. By this application we request specific license authorization to demonstrate a prototype Radiation Oil Gage (ROG) by flight test at Edwards Air Force Base. This gage utilizes approximately thirty (30) Co-60 sources of 38 micro-curies strength each. Each source is hermetically sealed in a stainless steel tube (type 3140), manufactured by U. S. Nuclear, Inc., Burbank, California. These sources will be mounted on an oil tank provided by the General Electric Company for use on its J-79 jet engine.

It is our intention to perform the instrumentation of the gage at Atomics International, Canoga Park, California, including the mounting of the sources on the tank. The tank will then be delivered to Edwards Air Force Base by Atomics International and installed on an aircraft which has been designated for the flight test. It has been established through discussions with Edwards Air Force Base personnel that the aircraft will be maintained in a hanger which is located in Township 10 N, Range 10 W, Section 36 of the Base. The installation of the tank and gage and removal after the flight test will be performed by qualified Atomics International personnel.
