NRC staff will visit the Yucca Mountain site and view selected cultural resources. NRC staff is conducting this visit to inform itself about the U. S. Department of Energy's (DOE's) draft supplemental Yucca Mountain environmental impact statement and DOE activities under the National Historic Preservation Act.

No commitments between NRC and DOE will be made during this visit, and no written reports or meeting summaries will be produced.

The site visit will be open to members of the public to observe, subject to logistical constraints and access requirements. The number of observers will be limited. Members of the public wishing to observe the site visit must contact April Gil at DOE by telephone (702-794-5578) or e-mail (April_Gil@ymp.gov) no later than Thursday, September 27, 2007, to arrange for site access. Observers should provide their own transportation to Mercury, Nevada (with no private vehicle access beyond Mercury), bring their own food and water, and wear appropriate clothing.
