This letter refers to the routine inspections conducted on September 12, 2007, at your Barboursville, West Virginia facility and on September 13, 2007, at your Princeton, West Virginia facility. The inspection results were discussed with Willie Regits of your staff during a final telephonic exit briefing conducted on September 19, 2007.

These inspections were an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, independent measurements, and observation of activities in progress. Within the scope of these inspections no violations of NRC requirements were identified; therefore, no response to this letter or the enclosed NRC Forms 591M Part 1 is required.
