Please review our responses to the questions that you have posed.

- a. Please describe the amount of time each week Dr. Peter Arfken will spend at Morgan Hospital & Medical Center, performing duties as RSO.

Reply: Dr. Arfken will be scheduled to be at the facility for the quarterly radiation safety meetings as scheduled and be available via pager or phone for consultation purposes 24/7.

- b. Please indicate the maximum amount of time it will take Dr. Peter Arfken to respond to an emergency involving radioactive material when he is not at Morgan Hospital & Medical Center.

Reply: Dr. Arfken will be able to respond immediately by phone to an emergency and that if a physical response is necessary; Dr. Arfken will be on site as soon as possible.

- c. Please describe any previous commitments Dr. Peter Arfken has as the RSO and/or authorized user at any other NRC licensed facility.

Reply: Dr. Arfken is the RSO for Northwest Radiology Network, location 10603 North Meridian. He is listed as an AU on the NRC license for Fishers Imaging Center, 11201 USA Parkway, Fishers, IN. He is listed as an AU for St. Vincent Hospitals, and he serves as Chairman of the Radiation Safety Committee for that organization.


- d. Since Dr. Peter Arfken will be the RSO at two facilities, please describe any adverse impact this will have on his duties as the RSO at Morgan Hospital & Medical Center. If there will be no adverse impact, please state so, and why.

Reply: Dr. Arfken will be available by pager and cell phone 24/7 and therefore there is no anticipated adverse affect to committing to two facilities.

- e. Please describe how Dr. Peter Arfken will divide his time between both facilities, Morgan Hospital & Medical Center and Northwest Radiology Network so that he will be able to adequately perform his duties as the Radiation Safety Officer.
