Subject: License (#42-26891-01) renewal questions

Reviewed sealed source inventory, use and model numbers with Mr. Perry based on entries in his renewal application dated 7/5/07. The Americium-241 Monsanto Model MRC is not to be included as licensee has disposed of it. The GNI Model CO-50 and 72-CO-200 cobalt-60 sources are not approved for down hole use and will only be listed for calibration and testing of logging tools. The Isotope Products Laboratories Model HEG-137 cesium-137 source should continue to be listed for temporary storage. It is still stuck in an active off shore well and decision to abandon has not been made yet.

The Sodern Corp. "Sodilog" tritium neutron generator is a custom device authorized only for Computalog Wireline Products, Inc. However, the licensee (Weatherford International & formerly Precision Energy Services) purchased Computalog and therefore now owns the "Sodilog". I advised Mr. Perry to contact the State of Texas and ask them to amend the sealed source and device registry for the Sodilog device to change the authorized user to Weatherford International.
