## **LACEY TOWNSHIP**

**OCEAN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**

- NOTES**
1. Development requiring wastewater facilities shall not be permitted in freshwater or tidal wetland areas, with the exception of those facilities determined by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection to be unavoidable.
  2. Wastewater facilities shall be provided to existing development, regardless of the presence of environmental constraints, in order to eliminate known septic system failures. These facilities will not be designed to promote or provide for additional development in environmentally sensitive areas.
  3. All designated sewer service area boundaries which are based on natural features such as wetlands, floodplains or drainage basins must be verified through on-site surveys of site conditions.
  4. Development located in areas which are not included within a designated sewer service area must use individual on-site sanitary septic systems in accordance with applicable regulations.

**AMENDED SEWER SERVICE AREAS**



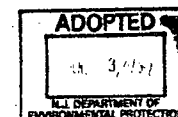
**WETLANDS AND FLOODPLAIN AREAS**
