This shipment consists of 10 x 30B Enriched UF6 Cylinders in sealed overpacks on 3 x 20' flatrack. RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, URANIUM HEXAFLUORIDE, FISSILE. Total net weight of U is 15,081.224 kgs. The net weight of U-235 is 621.206 kgs.


