Dear Dr. Sagar:

In accordance with the task order procedures of the subject contract, this letter definitizes Task Order No. 2. This effort shall be performed in accordance with the enclosed Statement of Work, and the Contractor's technical proposal dated September 4, 2007. Task Order No. 2 shall be in effect from September 28, 2007 through September 27, 2009, with a cost ceiling of \$242,638. The amount of \$224,975 represents the total estimated reimbursable costs, and the amount of \$17,663 represents the fixed fee for this task order.

Incremental funding in the amount of \$30,000 is provided by this order. Of this amount \$27,777 represents the estimated costs and \$2,223 represents the fixed fee. It is estimated that this amount will cover task order performance through November 2007.




