Assurances from EURATOM that the material will be subject to all the terms and conditions of an agreement for cooperation, are required. Your assistance in obtaining the necessary assurances will be appreciated.

Please note that the proposed export contains Canadian and EURATOM-obligated material. It, thus, has Canadian and EURATOM obligations.

In addition, please note that the applicant's first shipment date is scheduled for November 26, 2007, and therefore, they are requesting expedited review and processing of this application.
