As required by 10 CFR 74.17(a) and the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan (FNMCP), the United States Enrichment Corporation (USEC) is submitting to the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), the SNM and SM Physical Inventory Summary Report for the Portsmouth, Ohio, Gaseous Diffusion Plant. The Form 327 covers the inventory period December 1, 2007 through January 31, 2008. This information was taken at 1400 hours on January 31, 2008.

- Enclosure 2 provides additional notes regarding the inventory data.


