As required by 10 CFR 74.17(a) and the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan (FNMCP), the United States Enrichment Corporation (USEC) is submitting to the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), the SNM and SM Physical Inventory Summary Report for the Portsmouth, Ohio, Gaseous Diffusion Plant. These Form 327 documents in Enclosures 1 through 6 cover the inventory period ending September 30, 2008. The inventory was taken at 1400 hours on September 30, 2008 for the cascade inventory. The rest of the data represents inventories as of September 30, 2008, and cover the annual period from September 29, 2007 through September 30, 2008.

- Enclosures 1 through 6 include inventory data for the Portsmouth plant.
- Enclosure 7 provides additional notes regarding the inventory data.

Enclosures 1 through 7 contain information concerning USEC's material control and accounting program for special nuclear material at the plant. As such, Enclosures 1 through 7 contain confidential commercial or financial information that is exempt from public disclosure pursuant to Section 1314 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and 10 CFR 2.390(a)(4), 2.390(d)(1) and 9.17(a)(4). USEC hereby requests that Enclosures 1 through 7 be withheld from public disclosure based on 10 CFR 2.390(d), which states, in part:
