On January 28, 2008, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Dominion Energy Kewaunee, Inc. (DEK) an Order (EA-07-195), "Issuance Of Order For Implementation Of Additional Security Measures And Fingerprinting For Unescorted Access For Certain Spent Fuel Storage Licensees - Kewaunee Power Station Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation." DEK answered the Order in a February 15, 2008 (Serial No. 08-0039) letter and requested a relaxation of the schedule for the completion of the additional security measures. On July 15, 2008 the NRC granted the relaxation of the Order implementation date to "90 days before the first day that spent fuel is initially placed in the ISFSI," and requested that DEK provide an updated schedule regarding ISFSI completion and proposed initial spent fuel loading. That schedule was provided in a November 13, 2008 letter (Serial No. 08-0478).

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that Kewaunee Power Station is in compliance with the January 28, 2008 Order, having completed the actions identified in our response to the Order. 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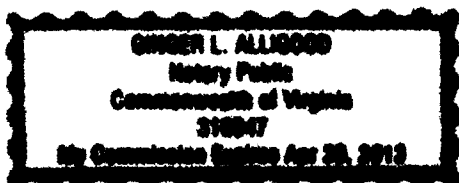
