Your letter of May 21, 2009, requested that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission approve an amendment to the Hematite license to permit a 10 CFR 20.2002 alternate disposal and to grant exemptions to 10 CFR 30.3 and 10 CFR 70.3 and to concur with Westinghouse Electric Company's records of transfer approach for special nuclear material.

We have performed an acceptance review of your May 21st submittal and have determined that it is sufficient for the staff to begin their review of the proposed changes to the license application and to the Hematite license. We will be publishing in the Federal Register a Notice of Opportunity to Comment on the proposed amendment and a Notice to request an Opportunity for Hearing for this action.
