Enclosed is one copy of the Wright County Dispatch Center Final Drill Report. The Drill was conducted in Buffalo, Minnesota, on May 6, 2009, to evaluate the new Wright County Dispatch Center.


The Wright County Dispatch Center is now located in the 10S Sub-Area of the 10-Mile Emergency Planning Zone for the Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant. It is the primary and backup activation site of the 58 sirens used to notify the public in the 10-Mile Emergency Planning Zone of the Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant. Participants included members from the State of Minnesota Homeland Security and Emergency Management, Wright County Sheriff's Department, Wright County Emergency Management and Northern States Power Minnesota (Xcel Energy.)

No Deficiencies or Areas Requiring Corrective Action were identified during this drill. Please see the enclosed drill report and narratives for further details.
