Dear Mr. Larsen:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff has completed its review of "Cimarron's Response to NRC's Comments on the Final Status Survey Plan (FSSP) for Phase II Areas," for the former nuclear fuels fabrication facility near Crescent, Oklahoma, dated January 8, 1997. NRC staff has concluded that Cimarron has provided adequate information and presented satisfactory responses to all issues that were raised in its October 31, 1996, letter to Cimarron. NRC staff also notes that many of the issues raised in the January 31 letter were resolved through discussions between NRC staff and Cimarron staff and consultants, and that Cimarron provided appropriate supporting documents as was requested by NRC staff during these discussions.

Therefore, NRC staff considers all issues pertaining to the Cimarron Corporation FSSP for Phase II Areas as resolved, and approves the FSSP for Phase II Areas.
