

Dear Mr. Norelius:

Cimarron Corporation has submitted reports for the release of SNM in effluents to unrestricted areas for the Cimarron Facility plutonium and uranium plants in accordance with 10 CFR 70.59. Both the uranium and plutonium facilities have undergone extensive decontamination and decommissioning activity. The plutonium plant decommissioning has been completed and termination of License SNM-1174 is pending. The uranium plant decontamination and decommissioning (License SNM-928) is nearly complete with all major exhaust systems removed.
