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**Re: Calvert Cliffs 3 Nuclear Project, LLC, and
UniStar Nuclear Operating Services, LLC
(Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 3),
Docket No. 52-016-COL**

Dear Administrative Judges:

As the Licensing Board and parties are aware from the filings to date on Contention 1 in this proceeding, the Applicants for a combined construction permit and operating license (“COL”) for Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 3, are domestic subsidiaries of UniStar Nuclear Energy, LLC (“UniStar”). UniStar has been owned in equal shares, through intermediary parent companies, by Constellation Energy Group, Inc. (“Constellation”), a U.S. corporation, and Électricité de France, S.A. (“EDF”), a French limited company. As has been reported in the media, Constellation and EDF last week announced an agreement by which EDF would acquire Constellation’s 50% interest in UniStar. That transaction was completed on November 3, 2010.

The Applicants have engaged in discussions with the NRC Staff regarding this transaction and will be submitting additional information on the licensing docket. In particular, the Applicants will review the COL application and will submit revisions to the application as necessary to address the acquisition by EDF of the Constellation interest in UniStar. The revisions to the application will also address a proposed negotiation action plan with respect to EDF’s participation in the project, as contemplated by the NRC Final Standard Review Plan on Foreign Ownership, Control, or Domination, 64 Fed. Reg. 52,355 (Sept. 28, 1999).

In its Memorandum, dated July 14, 2010, the Licensing Board addressed the briefing schedule for summary disposition motions regarding Contention 1. The Licensing Board noted at that time that the Applicants intended to file additional information related to Contention 1 on the licensing docket in July or August 2010. The Board requested that the

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Applicants notify the Board if plans change significantly from that described previously. We provided additional information by letter dated August 27, 2010.

In light of the transaction described above, this letter supersedes my letter on this subject dated August 27, 2010. At this time, the Applicants have not identified a target date for submission of a COL application amendment related to the transaction as described above. Nor have the Applicants determined how the transaction and application changes will affect its prior plans to file a motion for summary disposition with respect to Contention 1. We will notify the Licensing Board and parties with additional information when available.
