I just wanted to give you an update based on my telephone conversation this morning with Steve Schilthelm (BWXT – Project manager).

<DCGL Material

No decision has yet been made on the island carve out concept vs. direct transport/disposal by another entity.

Licensee will be having further discussions tomorrow and it is anticipated that at that time a contractor will be selected. Although a contractor will be selected it appears that it may take up 1 month before the contract is finalized. During this time, the Licensee will make a decision as to how the <DCGL material will be removed off-site for disposal and under whose license.

The Licensee anticipates providing formal notification via letter as to the selected option.

Request for meeting

Licensee would like to meet with NRC to discuss expectations for license termination sometime in late-Feb. 2011. I told Steve that the NRC is currently reviewing the finalized FSSP. He indicated that he has requested from the Corps a copy of this document.
