"Incidental take of an unresponsive Kemps-Ridley sea turtle from the dilution plant bay #4.

"Brigantine Marine Stranding Center has been notified and transfer of custody took place at 1950 hours.
National Marine Fisheries Service was contacted at 2000 hours.

"Initial diagnosis by Brigantine techs indicated that the turtle had been dead a couple of days based on decay."
