On March 23, 2011, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) tasked the staff to establish a senior level agency task force to conduct a methodical and systematic review of NRC processes and regulations to determine whether the agency should make additional improvements to our regulatory system and make recommendations to the Commission for its policy direction. Consistent with that direction, the Task Force Report, with its recommendations for agency actions following the events in Japan, is attached for the Commission's consideration. The tasking memorandum also directed the staff to provide the Commission with estimated resource impacts before starting work on the longer-term review.
