On July 7, 2011, Honeywell submitted a revised application to remove Japan from the list of potential origin countries from which Honeywell might export ore against this export license. Honeywell's explanation for why Japan was listed on the original application is that they used an XSNM export license application for UF6 as a model and did not remove countries that did not make sense to be included on an XSOU license application.
