We wish to request the following amendments to our BROADSCOPE Type A license 06-19183-01.

- Increase our license limit for ^{33}P Phosphorus (^{33}P) from 300 millicuries to 5 Curies and our license limit for ^{35}S Sulfur (^{35}S) from 300 millicuries to 5 Curies.

This request is based on our anticipated future needs for ^{33}P and ^{35}S -labeled research compounds.

We believe that the modifications requested will not compromise any of our safety programs or our ability to maintain excellent compliance with U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission regulations and License conditions. These changes have been reviewed and approved by our Radiation Safety Committee.
